We run a 24 hour service 7 days a week at the property for people with moderate to low needs, with sleep in support. Our team structure consists of a manager, house leader with care and support staff. The staff deployed at this service include one staff on AM shift, one staff on a mid-shift, one staff on PM shift, and sleep in support. Extra staff is provided for any 1:1 requirements as part of an individual's care plan.

Our services are designed to enable adults living with long term mental health conditions to improve their quality of life and encouraging the greatest possible engagement with the community either within our homes or through our step down services.
